## Youth Foundation Grants Information for Applicants

### *Who can apply?*

1. any student residing in the Eurobodalla Shire area bounded by Durras North, Nelligen and the Moruya River who is completing their secondary education at any school or TAFE college (at Year 12 level or earlier) this year or who has deferred university for a year, if it is their intention to undertake in the following year a worthwhile career option including:
  - a course of study at an Australian university or TAFE;
  - any other form of personal development including, but not limited to, music, art, sport or research.
2. any student attending Moruya High School and who intends to enrol in a course at the University of Canberra, Australian National University or University of Wollongong. Please indicate this intention in the 'Proposed Use of this Grant' section of the Application form.

### *Closing date for applications*

Applications must be received by the Youth Foundation by **30 November** each year.

### *How much is the grant worth?*

Substantial grants are given to assist students to pursue their career options, particularly those who live away from home. The amount of every grant is determined by the Youth Foundation.

### *When is the grant paid?*

Successful university applicants will receive approximately 80% of the grant at a **Presentation Dinner** held at the Batemans Bay Soldiers Club in February each year. In July, the Youth Foundation will ask awardees to provide a brief half yearly progress report before issuing the balance of the grant.

### *How can this grant be used?*

This grant is to be used to assist with living expenses and the costs of training and education associated with your chosen career.

### *How will applications be judged?*

The Youth Foundation Selection Committee considers all the information provided on the Application Form to help establish an applicant's performance record at school, financial need and the perceived future potential for success. It is therefore essential that applicants provide the full details requested on the Application Form. Applicants must also provide some evidence of their results and course offers under *Supporting Evidence*.

### *Presentation Dinner*

All successful applicants are expected to attend the **Presentation Dinner** as a guest of the Youth Foundation. Parents and guests are invited. Permission will be sought for a photograph to be placed on the Awards Wall at the Batemans Bay Soldiers Club and for use for other purposes associated with the work of the Youth Foundation.

### *Who sponsors these grants?*
